- The Great Seal** - giant caricature celebrating America's the fascinating history.
- Envision Yourself in Fantasy World** – Mirrored fantasy painting that you become a part of as you approach.

### 2. *Gerald R Ford Museum | 303 Pearl St NW*

- Waterwall** - 24 prints & drawings with embedded fiber optic lighting to give the appearance of moving water.
- A Series of Handmade Japanese Paper Cut Sculptures** – Life-sized swimming polar bear sculpture hand cut from (1) 3m x 3m sheet of paper.
- NOW** – 3D sculpture of more than 1200 clocks
- Music Go-Round** – Circular fence that visitors can play like a musical instrument
- Looking for Alice** – Mechanical Mad Hatter sculpture (from Alice in Wonderland) on a large tricycle
- kNights Watch** – sculpture of Knights protecting a Golden Goose from a Dragon.
- I LOVE MY RESCUE** – animal sculpture
- I Hear the Train a Comin'** – large "in progress" train mural the artist will finish during ArtPrize.
- Dawn of Chimes** – a raptor created out of numerous musical instruments.
- Color Out the Darkness** – huge colorful pillars

### 3. *Ah-Nab-Awen Park | 303 Pearl Street NW*

- Before I Die** – Public art wall where people share personal aspirations of what they want to do before they die.
- Metanoia: You Are Here** - life-sized human figures cut from mirror polished stainless steel to show diversity.

### 4. *Gillette Bridge*

- The Grand River Check Point** - this checkpoint will be complete with guardhouse, Gillette Bridge border control officer, and an array of regulatory and informational signs

### 5. *Bridgewater Place | 333 Bridge St*

- Where the Wild Things Grow** – painted plastic bottles used to create hanging sculpture
- Noah's Art, The Promise** - 9 foot by 50 foot ink pen drawing of Noah's Ark
- I'm Being Attacked by the 1812 Overture** – collage shows ending of the famous song
- Great Plate State** – 350+ license plates to create a Michigan outline
- From within** - conceptual sculpture that consists of a high powered laser system refracting off of a silvered convex lens.
- Dragon's Lair** - a layered Lego mosaic built with over 200,000 Lego pieces.
- Build Bridges** – colorful mosaic bridge. Rocks of the bridges were created by children from shoe prints on old jeans.
- Awakening** – exquisite painting of water

### 6. *Plante Moran | 634 Front Ave NW*

- Bike Wreck** – giant bike print

### 7. *Fish Ladder Park | 634 Front Ave NW*

- playCAGE** - a huge-scale, fully-interactive Chance Instruction sculpture. Guitar strings stretch over 128 feet, 24 feet across the base of the Fish Ladder, and 40 feet along the rapids of the Grand River. Please Touch!

### 8. *The Mitten Brewing Company | 527 Leonard St NW*

- A Dragon Trophy** – Dragon sculpture has over 2100 hand cut meticulously welded scales and 86 hand crafted ferocious teeth plus a sword.

### 9. *Boardwalk Condominiums | 940 Monroe Ave NW*

- The Shared Light of Consciousness** – a careful arrangement of colorful lights and more than 200 handcrafted and glass-blown leaves
- Out of the Box** – melted crayons and their boxes used to create a rainbow waterfall picture
- Nature's Ultimatum** – walk by from each direction to see a different/outcome view of the tree
- Fiesta In GR** - an interactive piece that combines folk dance, sculpture and live art forms.
- Extraterrestrial Succulence** – large colorful mural painted on building
- Dinosaurs Don't Wear Wigs** - a large scale, functioning, children's book.

  - Pods** – Put your head inside of these pods and become part of the sculpture
  - Murmuration** – 10'x10'x18' hanging display of crochet thread and feathers.
  - Itswell wave** – wave made from found wood after Hurricane Sandy
11. *Auto Fixit Body Shop | 805 Ottawa Avenue NW*
  - Da Race ArtPrize**- Spray painted race cars and ice cream trucks in a race
12. *DeVos Place Convention Center | 303 Monroe Avenue NW*
  - Think** – Giant thinking head made of multiple objects.
  - On a Golden Autumn Day** – neon autumn leaves
  - Michigan in Motion**- walk past to get visual experience of multiple Michigan paintings
  - Liquid Rock** - 3-D "painting" or lava using foil and acrylic
  - JARTPRIZE** – giant lawn darts display
  - Gold Fever** – Large horse sculpture made from recycled materials
  - Einstein**- 4'x6' painting of Einstein
  - Building Neighbors** - 1000 handmade paper house shaped drawings, ranging in size from 1 inch to about 10 inches tall.
  - Big Michigan** – giant rotating, kinetic cherry
  - Back to nature** – walk into the cube to view nature scene diorama
13. *Calder Plaza | 300 Monroe NW*
  - WebJutsu** – large, inflated plastic pillows illuminated with color
  - Two Birds** – Vegetable oil-powered school bus/house
  - Loveness** - an over-sized sculpture of a "sphinx like seated lion with a space helmet on... 35 feet long, 8 feet wide, 15 feet high.
  - Gorilla!!!**- large-scale inflatable gorilla that will be customized during ArtPrize.
14. *Fifth Third Bank | 111 Lyon NW*
  - Protect Our Children** – large sculpture of a mother whale with a baby close at her side.
  - Mijimendan vta Ziibi (Remember the River)** - wrapping the 5/3 Bank building in downtown Grand Rapids with neon blue ribbon/fabric intended to look like meandering river waters. Additional luminous piece built from various widths of loosely woven fabric will radiate out from the building to visually invoke the Grand River. Audience members will be able to walk under and through hundreds of feet of rippling and glowing strips of fabric.
- Kevin Connolly Gillespie** - four large panels depicting waves crashing off the east coast as a storm approaches.
- Fly** – colorful hanging strips of "flypaper"
- Figures in Motion** - a group of figurative steel sculptures ranging in size from 3 to 20 feet tall. There will be a very large central kinetic figure surrounded by multiple smaller figures.
- A Baling Wire Horse** - approximately 10 feet tall and with a depth of about 6 feet, it is a life-sized recreation of a quarter horse rearing up in its own air space.
- Autumn Cathedral** - a watercolor consisting of 25 panels which all connect to form a view of a towering canopy decked out in fall colors found in a Michigan forest.

  - Joy's Horizon, Bridging Communities** - Rainbow fence made out of recycled bottles
16. *St Mark's Episcopal Church | 134 North Division Ave*
  - The Queens Silver Steed** – giant aluminum rocking giraffe
17. *Kendall College of Art and Design | 17 Pearl St NW*
  - Capitalism Works For Me** – Interactive voting on capitalism
  - Operation Paydirt/Fundred Dollar Bill Project** – draw your own Fundred dollar bills to help raise awareness of childhood lead poisoning
  - The Hair Craft Project** – photographs document hairstyles
18. *Downtown GR INC | 29 Pearl NW*
  - After Mardi Gras**- leftover bead used to bead a bike
19. *Sundance Grill| 151 Ottawa Ave NW Waters Building*
  - Bubble's Wild Ride** – paint on aluminum depicting a wild, red headed mermaid rides sidesaddle on a fiery hippocampus, careening through the sea, with "Bubbles" the sea turtle whipping behind in the wake, hanging on for dear life!
20. *Kilwin's | 146 Monroe Center*
  - Rolando** - an enormous version of the upcoming Goo Guys & Gals<sup>®</sup>™ book "Rolando Responsible" – including (28) 4'x4' pages
  - Paints** – large tile art painting
  -

- tReE** – 8'x10' interconnected tree sculpture
- The Pond** – 8'x12' pond made of hundreds of carved ripples and raindrop splashes
- Blackfish** – large sculpture with 10 Orcas and 3 ice forms.

22. *MLive | 169 Monroe Ave Suite 100]*

- Windows to Michigan** – images of our community fill the windows at MLive

23. *99 Monroe*

- Monster of the Day** - 50 whimsical, original monster paintings.
- Prime Commonality** – (7) 7' tall pillars are illuminated from within. They are styled to represent human and chimpanzee chromosomal chromosomes.
- Sunday Afternoon in West Michigan** – (seen from the skywalk Panera) – mural of West MI afternoons

24. *Louis Campau Promenade | Campau Promenade*

- Perso/Trovo (Lost/Found) Grand Rapids 1826** – triumphal arch of fiberglass milk crates

25. *JW Marriott | 235 Louis St NW*

- Orchids in 3D** – High def 3D painting with no need for 3D glasses.
- In God We Trust** – large drawing of bald eagle
- EyeFrog** – bright, colorful painting of frog and co.

26. *Blue Bridge*

- Walk-In Camera Obscura**

27. *Grand River*

- Self-Portrait as Bunnies (The Bathers)** – a floating sculpture made of 2 people-bunnies facing each other

28. *Courtyard Marriott Downtown | 11 Monroe Ave NW*

- Inspired by Chihuly**- recycled painted bottle sculpture
- If everyone does a little**- self-portraits of local children
- First Flight** – bicycle with dragon wings
- Kiss of Grand Rapids** - series of colored pencil paintings are all titled 'Kisses from.....' and are cityscapes made up of vintage and current lipsticks.

29. *Plaza Towers | 201 West Fulton St*

- Gentlemen, Don't Start Your Engines** – large play on match box cars and race tracks

30. *The B.O.B. | 20 Monroe Ave NW*

- Wild Horses** - a 23'x7' wood wall sculpture depicting a colorful stampede of Red and White Paint horses.
- They call the wind Mariah** – Life-sized hood ornament
- Teepee at the BOB** – hand-carved stone sculptures of 4 Native American chiefs displayed in a large teepee that you can go inside of
- Synchronocity** – 100+ wood carved pieces plus 3D art nested within translucent glass sculptures to illuminate the night with ever-shifting rays of colored light.
- Poseidon's Paradise** – Huge display includes 20 sculptures of sea life
- Perspective** – look in the eye of the zebra to see a rhino
- Beauty in Brokenness** – backlit sculpture includes broken light bulbs to reveal the filaments inside
- Art Show Cosmo** – Cosmo Joe creates artwork with spray paint as part of a live show
- Atomic Structures in Six Dimensional Geometry** - a set of six dimensional stained glass models about 12' in diameter

31. *Grand Rapids Art Museum | 101 Monroe Center*

- Always Nowhere** - A road movie where no one goes anywhere, Always Nowhere is a video sculpture that transposes windows for screens, evoking the dualities that occur while riding in a car
- Shattered** - large-scale faux broken window that you can touch

32. *Vault of Midnight | 95A Monroe Center NW*

- Robo Invasion** – Glow in the dark robot comic book panel

33. *SiTE:LAB @ The Morton | 72 Monroe Center NW*

- Space Drawing #36** - pass through, around and under the patterned lines which seemingly grow from the ceiling, walls and floor
- Sliding Architecture** - Using video cameras and projectors, Sliding Architecture, places participants into interactive engagement with the built environment and transforms the building.
- Chung King House of Metal** – Boom boxes rewired to play music written & performed by a one man show

- **Roundabout2** - Two motorcycles are "tied" together and circle each other. Madly spinning, the throttles are wide open and the bikes release all of their stored energy moving freely in a space creating burned rubber marks.
- 34. *Gerald R Ford Federal Building | 110 Michigan St NW*
  - **Sea of Love – over** 5,000 blocks of painted LoVE signs.
- 35. *MoDiv | 40 Monroe Center*
  - **Spark of Freedom, Superior Storms** - hand carved wooden ship and painting with carve ships coming out of it.
  - **The Beaded Tree** – Over 200,000 beads make up this tree & sky scene.
- 36. *Grand Rapids Children's Museum | 11 Sheldon Ave NE*
  - **Michigan Totem Pole** – animals native to Michigan and native American symbols carved into totem pole
  - **Blink** – fantastical, interactive adventure storyboard full of color, wonder and laughter.
  - **The Cooperative Phonograph** – Play with sound. One person spins huge record disc to maintain the rotation frequency (musical pitch), while another person holds the sound wave scraper and controls the amplitude (volume) of the musical experience.
  - **Numbers Everywhere** - A 3-D, time-based, mixed media sculpture (and song).
  - **Giraffe Pixels** – Painted giraffes on 15 wood panels.
- 37. *UICA | 2 Fulton West*
  - **Pony Ride** - a mechanical horse, fully active, walking in a "pony ride" circle.
  - **Peralux** – original light and animation sensory experience
  - **Animation Collaboration** - inter-generational animation collaboration between artists, educators, students and local/international organizations.
- 38. *First Park Cong. Church | 10 E Park Place NE*
  - **2014 Grand Island Ice Caves** – photographs of upper peninsula ice caves from 2014
  - **Three Fish** - 3 fish sculptures. Each fish is chasing its dinner.
  - **Nature's Children** – large mixed media mural of children and nature.
  - **MacEgan Castle**
  - **Mrs. Wezeman's Cookies** - 8 large legs (11 foot tall) stand in contrast to the central figure that is 5 foot tall. Visitors will be able to walk through the forest-like structure to revisit a child's perception of the world.

  - **Blossoms of Hope** – colorful ceramic flower garden
- 40. *Central Reformed Church | 10 College NE*
  - **There will be light** – walk-in ART/SOCIAL EXPERIMENT Many different elements including sculpture, LED lights, waterfalls, LAVA LAMP BENCHES, and much more
  - **Life is a carnival** - a large carved elephant with a circus on its back.

  - **Picking Up the Pieces** – 7'x3' painted tornado landscape
  - **Lake of the Clouds Sunrise** – large panoramic photo of UP's Lake of the Clouds
  - **Conga Line** – B&W Zebra photograph

  - **The 5 Seasons of Love** – 5 large pencil drawings representing the different seasons of life
  - **The Zoo** – a zoo full of creatures created from found objects.

  - **Weave Peace** - 30' diameter dome woven over with color that you can walk through.
  - **Urban Scavenger Hunt** – Scavenger hunt supports Special Olympics in Michigan.
  - **Shimmer** – Large 3-D image on aluminum tiles that moves and shimmers with the breeze.
  - **Supporting the World** - Joyful family of bronzed turtles
  - **Perspectives on Transformation in Community** - Giant historical photographs of Grand Rapids, strategically placed to allow observers a look back on that spot in history.
  - **The Mudpuppy** – Large sculpture of a diver taking his pet bulldog for a walk on the ocean floor.
  - **Grand River Fish Petroglyph** – the story of Grand Rapids told by rock carvings of fish, the Grand River and the 6<sup>th</sup> St dam.
  - **Grand Gathering** – playful, mystical seed pods having been transported by the Grand River and delivered to the river's edge.

  - ☐ **Conservate NOT Captivate** - series of portraits with watercolor paintings of endangered animals.
48. *Georgio's Gourmet Pizza | 15 Ionia*
  - ☐ **Seewall** - 7 ft x 35 ft painting of sealife
49. *Van Andel Arena | 130 West Fulton*
  - ☐ **LOVE ArtPrize** - Giant LOVE installation....constructed of metal, glass & led light...the LOVE installation has different looks at daytime& nighttime...great photo op
  - ☐ **Jet Powered Trike** – giant trike pieced together from multiple materials. Over 20 feet long.
  - ☐ **Egg Prize** – put in coins to get your egg prize.
50. *Grand Rapids Griffins | 130 W. Fulton Suite 111*
  - ☐ 10 customs masks representing different aspects of the Griffins team. Masks are giant and eye-level.
51. *Calvin College Art Center | 106 South Division*
  - ☐ **Wash** - Corrugated plastic traditionally used for signage is cut, melted, and suspended to fill large, open spaces.
52. *Buffalo Wild Wings | 8 Ionia*
  - ☐ Artbydirt – giant eagle sculpture with glowing eyes
53. *Oakes Street Park | 67 Ionia Ave SW*
  - ☐ **Play for Peace Guitar** – 10' tall guitar covered in glass mosaic
  - ☐ **Harrison Park Buddy Bench** - sculptural mosaic bench made by GR Public school students
54. *Cornerstone Church | 48 Lafayette*
  - ☐ **Somewhere in Michigan** – huge Michigan mural painted on the building
55. *Lantern Coffee Bar | 100 Commerce SE*
  - ☐ **Yarnbomb Everything** - two yarnbombed bicycles for outside and many other yarnbombed objects inside and outside the shop
56. *Action Building | 98 East Fulton St.*
  - ☐ **Show Your Colors Stand Out From the Crowd** - large, multi-colored zebra made of textiles
57. *Harris Building | 111 S. Division*
  - ☐ **1001 Coffee Cups** – artist drew on 1001 coffee cups, now in a hanging display
  - ☐ **Trees** – Old books used to make trees
  - ☐ **Class is in Session** – a room of 2D students participating in classroom art session
  - ☐ **Glass wall flower sculptures** - vibrant and bold glass flower sculptures
58. *Peppino's Pizza | 130 Ionia SW*
  - ☐ **Octahedron Crystal** – 6-8 ft sculpture made out of octahedrons
  - ☐ **Copper Derby** – Large horse figurine made out of copper
59. *Western MI University | 200 Ionia SW*
  - ☐ **Jellies** - Seven translucent mixed media jellies approximately 7' high each and lit from within.
60. *GR Downtown Market*
  - ☐ **Bloom Bloom** – Giant display suspended from ceiling. Includes flashing lights, dancing tinsel and fluorescent colors
  - ☐ **A B See?** - 26 alphabetically themed 24" x 24" acrylic canvases painted through a child's lens so the work take twists like L is for elephant (if you sound it out...)
61. *Westminster Pres Church | 47 Jefferson SE*
  - ☐ **Regarding humanity** - welded steel frames affixed with springs and hand-woven with holographic thread.
62. *PNC Bank | 171 Monroe Avenue NW*
  - ☐ **Never never never never give up-** two late model Indy Cars, full size replicas, made entirely out of recycled steel and auto parts, racing wheel to wheel.
63. *Canal Park | 941 Monroe Ave*
  - ☐ **Light Sculptures**
64. *CityFlats Hotel | 83 Monroe Center NW*
  - ☐ **What remains** - basic forms of furniture turned inside out.
65. *Front Ave under US-131*
  - ☐ **Walk with me.** – painted arches on walls of underpass

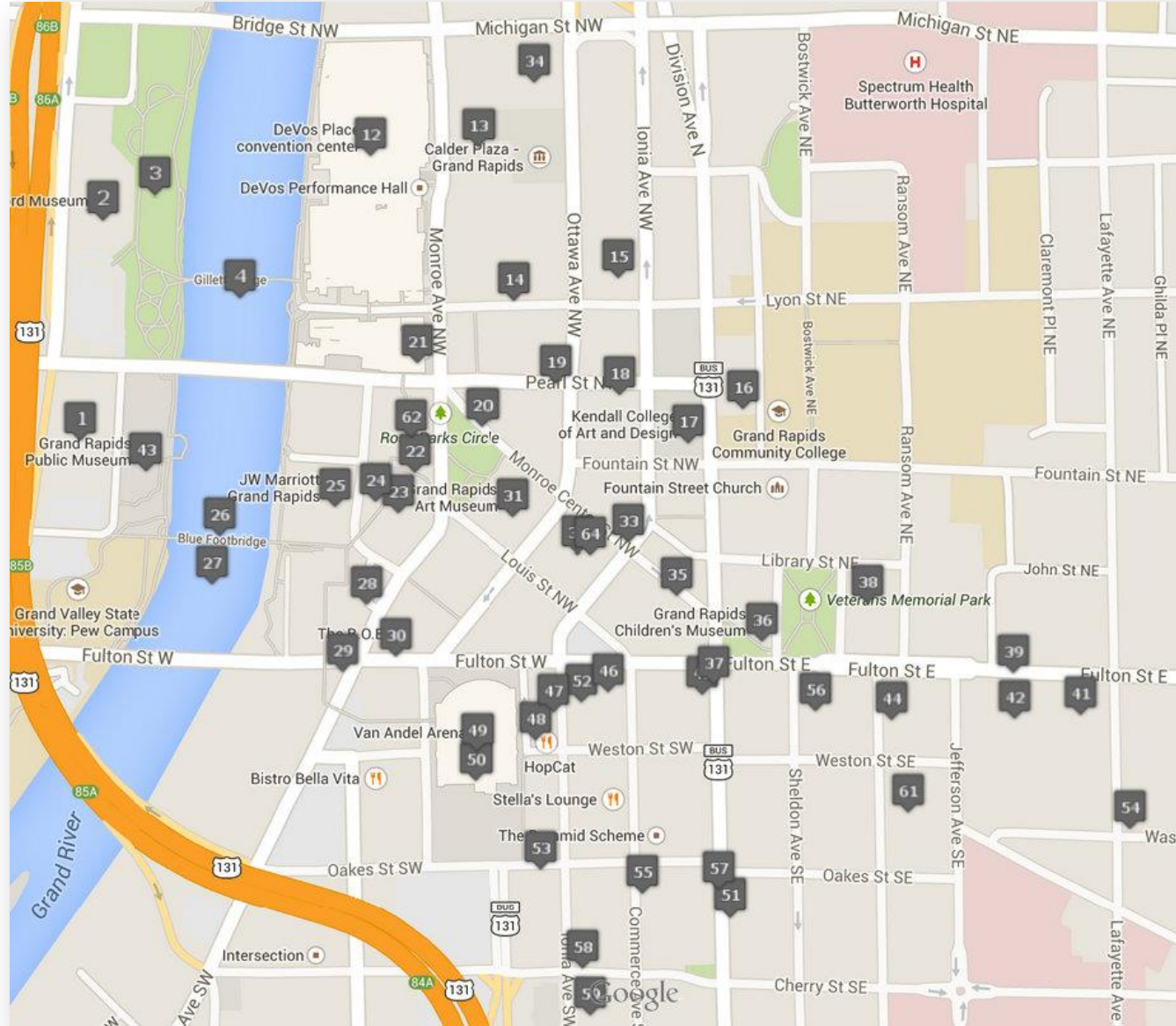
